Public Comments: Members of the Public are allowed to speak during that period of the meeting identified on the meeting agenda as “Public Comment” provided that each person wishing to speak has completed and submitted to the Secretary of the meeting a comment card at the beginning of the meeting prior to the item identified as “Public Comment.” Public comment shall be allowed only on items that are identified on the meeting agenda. If an item is subsequently added to the agenda, additional public comment shall be permitted just prior to the consideration of such item. If there are multiple members of the public associated with the same company, group or faction, the number of members of the public allowed to speak representing that company, group or faction shall be limited to three. Other comments are welcome at the discretion of the Chair. The time to comment shall be limited to 3 minutes and such time may be extended at the discretion of the Chair. Comments and comment cards will become public records.
