 - c. Educational partners added course work for the current and coming semester, increased cohort sizes and added classes for Spanish speaking students in the evening. Pathway was updated live during the meeting.
 - d. Classes were deleted due to continuous low enrollment.
 - e. Classes were updated based on different campus locations.
